Surf Camp/Tour Code Of Behaviour

Surftrek and SC Surfsschools has set down guidelines in relation to the code of behaviour of members, surfers, parents, officials and staff. Serious breaches of behaviour could result in the Camp/Tour Director or Camp/Tour Manager immediately expelling the offender from the camp/tour and sending them home. Any costs incurred by this action are the responsibility of the offending individual and / or their parents or guardians. In the case of junior surfers, management would expect that the parents/guardians would take full responsibility for their actions / behaviour and any costs incurred.

General Code of Behaviour

As a participant of Surftrek and SC Surfsschools surf camps and tours, you are obliged to meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any activity held or sanctioned by Surftrek and SC Surfsschools or under the auspices of Surfing Australia / Surfing Queensland, a member association, or an affiliated club:

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others
2. Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others
3. Be professional in, and accept responsibility for your actions
4. Be aware of, and maintain an uncompromising adherence to Surftrek and SC Surfsschools standards, rules, regulations and policies
5. Refrain from any form of harassment of others
6. Refrain from any behaviour that may bring Surftrek and SC Surfsschools, Surfing Australia, or Surfing Queensland into disrepute
7. Understand the repercussions if you breach, or are aware of any breaches of, this code of behaviour.

Participant's Code of Behaviour

In addition to the General Code of Behaviour, and as a participant of Surftrek and SC Surfsschools surf camps and tours, you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct while on surf camp/tour and in your role as a participant in any activity held by Surftrek and SC Surfsschools or under the auspices of Surfing Australia / Surfing Queensland, a member association, or an affiliated club:

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow participants, coaches, support staff and assisting parents
2. Do not tolerate acts of aggression
3. Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow surfing participants
4. Care for and respect the equipment provided to you as part of your surfing program
5. Be frank and honest with your coach/s concerning illness and injury and your ability to participate fully within the program requirements
6. Conduct yourself in a professional manner relating to language, temper and punctuality
7. Maintain high personal behaviour standards at all times
8. Abide by the rules and respect the decision of coaches, support staff and assisting parents
9. Cooperate with coaches, support staff and assisting parents at all times throughout the duration of the surf camp/tour.

Participant Declaration

In consideration of Surftrek and SC Surfsschools accepting my application to participate in the Program, ("Program" for the purposes of this declaration means and includes Surftrek and SC Surfsschools surf camps and tours) below I acknowledge, understand and agree that:

1. "Surf School" for the purposes of this declaration means and includes Surftrek, SC Surfsschools, North Stardbroke Island Surf School, Tropicsurf, Redland Shire Council, Surfing Queensland, Surfing Australia Inc ("SA"), SA affiliated state surfing associations, and their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.
2. Warning: Participating in the Program can be inherently dangerous. I understand the nature and requirements of the Program and acknowledge that serious accidents can and often do happen which may result in me being seriously injured or even killed. I have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Program.
3. Physical Fitness: I must not participate in the Program if I have any injury, disability, medical or health condition that may increase the risk of me becoming injured unless I have told the Surf School about it and they have authorised me to participate. I declare that I am medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Program and I will immediately notify the Surf School of any change to my fitness and ability to participate.
4. Instructions: I will at all times comply with the instructions and safety procedures of the Surf School.
5. Medical Treatment: If required, the Surf School will arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for me. I authorise such actions being taken by the Surf School and agree to meet all costs associated with such action.
6. Release & Indemnity: My participation in the Program is entirely at my own risk and I agree to:
(a) release and forever discharge the Surf School from all liability and Claims that I may have or may have had but for this release arising from or in connection with my participation in the Program;

(b) indemnify and hold harmless the Surf School to the extent permitted by law in respect of any Claim by any person including but not only another participant in the Program arising as a result of or in connection with my participation in the Program.

In this clause 6 "Claims" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, penalty, cost or expense however arising (including negligence, trespass to the person or for breach of implied terms in the sale of services under section 74 of the Trade Practices Act (1974) Cth and equivalent provisions contained in State sale of goods or fair trading legislation).

7. Identity: Photographic and or visual images taken by the Surf School of my participation in the Program may be used for general promotion of the Organiser's activities.

8. Privacy: I understand that the information provided by me in this form is necessary for the operation of the Program. I acknowledge and agree that the information will only be used for the objects of the Surf School and to provide me with information pertaining to the Program. I understand that I will be able to access my information through the Surf School upon request. If the information is not provided I might not be permitted to participate in the Program.

I have read, understood, acknowledge and agree to the above declaration including the warning, release and indemnity.

I hereby authorise the obtaining on my behalf of such medical assistance as may be required in the event of accident or illness. (In the event of any injury or illness, parents will be contacted immediately)

Booking Conditions

The client agrees to make a booking under the following terms and conditions. They are as follows:

- A non-refundable deposit of 25% of the total cost of the surf camp/tour is required to secure the booking
- The balance of payment is due a minimum of 60 days prior to surf camp/tour commencement
- Additional forms will need to be completed by the client booking an overseas surf camp/tour.
- We highly recommend the client travelling overseas to take out their own travel insurance.
- Notification of any circumstantial changes to the booking to be made at least 60 days prior to the commencement of the surf camp/tour, otherwise SC SurfSchools will bill for the full remaining balance
- SC SurfSchools reserves the right to modify or cancel the surf camp/tour at short notice due to unforeseen circumstances (eg. severe weather, ocean conditions, changing political climates etc.)
